Bread that way: wheat out of place

The Bread Lab in Washington State breeds grains for non-commodity uses with nutrient density and flavour. Researchers in the lab work with community members, farmers, millers, bakers, chefs, maltsters, brewers and distillers to repatriate grain economies where they have been missing for up to 100 years in the coastal US including Alaska. One result is keeping value where it is produced. This seminar will cover work on wheat, barley, dry beans and buckwheat.

Dr Stephen Jones is a wheat breeder and the Director of the WSU Mount Vernon Bread Lab. Stephen has a Ph.D. in Genetics from the University of California at Davis and teaches graduate courses in advanced classical genetics and in the history and ethics of genetics.
